Wellington's 1932 National War Memorial Carillon Tower has always been highly visible throughout the city. The three year project to create a unified space surrounding this tower for large civic events was completed in 2015. A high priority was placed on the quality of landscaping and the mixed functionality of the shared spaces. To achieve this, State Highway 1 was diverted into the Arras tunnel and this involved the relocation of many services. To give secure access, AS3996 Class D access covers were required - and supplied by ACO.
