

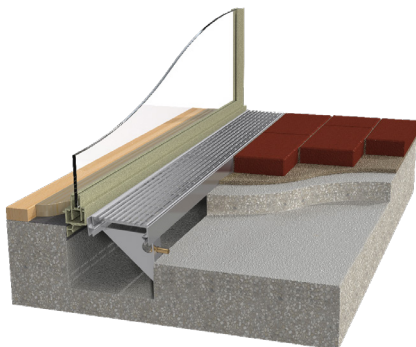

Boys High School Napier

The Boys High School in Napier was a project assigned from the Ministry of Education and took place between the end of 2019 and the beginning of 2020. The school needed a slip resistant drain along the building, complying with the E2 NZ Building Code. Meeting these requirements, ACO put forward its OnePour Threshold Drain together with Stainless Steel 5 Star **Heelsafe**® Anti-Slip grates for an aesthetic finish on top. Additionally the grates are wheelchair and walking cane friendly, ensuring safety for visitors and students.

- Protecting the entrance threshold from surface water entering the building, also runoff from doors and windows is collected during storms.
